Mayor Foss reported that the purpose of the Special Meeting was to conduct an interview with an applicant for the City of Menahga Public Works/Utilities Superintendent position.


Applicant Roger Avelsgard introduced himself and provided background information on his utilities work experience and licensure.


Following the interview, the Council discussed various points of the interview; current licensure, work experience, wage request and future goals.
