

MENAHGA CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING
Monday, June 9, 2014

A Public Hearing of the Menahga City Council was held in the Council Chambers on Monday, June 9, 2014. The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Mayor Pat Foss.

Also present: Council Members Kim Rasmussen, Roger Henstorf, Gary Parvi, Marty Ahlf. Staff: Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Char West. Public: Jensine Kurtti, Jim Lifgren and Matt Johnson, Review Messenger.

Mayor Foss reported that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to provide information and receive public comment regarding the proposed City of Menahga Transient Merchant Ordinance, as amended. He pointed out that the Amended Ordinance only effected City owned property and the current Ordinance would remain in effect for private property.


Jensine Kurtti questioned how the City would regulate a transient merchant's use of an empty store front.

Council response was that the Ordinance did not regulate private property, only City owned property.


Discussion was held regarding permitting of transient merchants on City property and the continued requirement of an agreement between the City and a vendor, except in the case of a community wide event where they would register with the event sponsor. Recommend adding wording in the application reflecting that every transient merchant on City property had to register and enter into an agreement, whether a fee was required or not.
